## **NEW BUSINESS:**

- **Bridge Question 1:** Since I am now working as a KHI employee for during those lab times, how is liability and work injury handled? Am I now having to go through them in the event of a work place injury. I have not been injured, but I work in a machine shop. This is a real potential risk.

Answer: If while working for KHI, an employee was to get hurt at work, we instruct them to call our Employee Relations Team first unless it was an emergency then they would call 911. When they call us after an injury, we direct them to call Medcor, which is an injury triage service available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. If they are unable to get ahold of our Employee Relations Team after an injury occurs, they can call Medcor directly at 1-800-775-5866. The nurse that they are connected with at Medcor will help determine the best course of medical treatment for the injury. When off-site care is needed, we will take care of working with the employee to get that set up and scheduled. Please let us know if there are any other questions on this. –Melissa Helmsing, HR
