CSSAC Excellence Award Nominations

Every year, CSSAC gives out two Excellence Awards to staff members who go above and beyond. All bi-weekly benefitted staff members who have been at PFW for at least one year are eligible. (Previous recipients are not eligible for 3 years immediately following their award but are eligible thereafter.) Awardees receive both a plaque and an award of \$250 and will be recognized at the Employee Recognition Dinner on March 26th.

One support staff member (administrative, clerical, etc.) and one service staff member (facilities, grounds, etc.) will receive awards. Nominate support staff with this form and service staff with this form.

Benefit Breakdown: AffirmedRX

Effective January 1st, our prescription plan is now administered by AffirmedRX. New medical cards were distributed in mid-December with updated prescription information. (If you have misplaced your card or did not receive a new one, please contact Amy Jagger in HR to request a new one.)

Previous in-network pharmacies are still in-network with AffirmedRX. As was with Caremark, you can fill your prescription wherever is most cost effective for you, be it Walgreens, CVS, Walmart, Meijer, etc. Our coverage remains the same; however, there may be some difference in cost due to their negotiations with pharmacies. With the switch to AffirmedRX, prescription costs become more transparent with much less frequent changes to the formulary list.

If you have mail order prescriptions, AffirmedRX will work with you to transfer them to Amazon pharmacy - <u>details here</u>. If you need help transferring your prescriptions, reach out to AffirmedRX's member support team at 1-765-601-9971.
