Dining On Campus

PFW offers plenty of options if you're hungry on campus. Most campus dining options are operated by Fresh Ideas (with the exception of Bon Bon's Coffee), which gives you lots of choices. While meal plans are charged to student accounts and therefore only available to staff if you are also a student, staff can use Don Dollars!

Meal Plans

Meal plans allow you to purchase packages of 3, 5, or 10 meals per week at Don's at Walb. Once you sign up and pay for your plan, simply swipe your Mastodon ID Card at checkout. Pre-paying for your meals with a meal plan is cheaper per meal than paying with cash or card. You can also add Don Dollars to a meal plan for even more flexible dining options. Don Dollars

Don Dollars is a separate account that you can access by swiping your Mastodon Card. You can purchase Don Dollars without getting a meal plan. Don Dollars are accepted at Einstein Bros Bagels, Don's at Walb, and Java Spot on campus—plus you get a 5% discount on your purchase for using Don Dollars. (Bon Bon's does not accept Don Dollars.) They are also accepted at Hungry Howie's, Don Tacos, CVS on the corner of Crescent Ave and Hobson Rd, and new this year can be used on the Grubhub app! Benefit Breakdown: AffirmedRX

In the new benefits year, AffirmedRX will be replacing CVS Caremark for non-specialty medications. AffirmedRX will offer dedicated patient care advocates specifically for the Purdue plan.

They will also have a more stable formulary list, or list of medications they cover. AffirmedRX changes their list less often than Caremark, and unlike Caremark, they will allow input from Purdue on those changes. This results in more predictable costs for you.

AffirmedRX also supports a wider network of pharmacies, including Amazon and Mark Cuban's Cost Plus.
