Resource Highlight: Community Counseling Center

PFW's Community Counseling Center provides counseling services to members of the community. It is also a training program for counseling graduate students—the students get experience in actual counseling situations, and community members get free counseling supervised by a faculty supervisor. They offer help with relationship and family issues, school problems, coping with loss, dealing with life adjustments, stress, depression, anxiety, and other problems.
