TRIO Student Support Services and TRIO Upward Bound

PFW has two federal TRIO grant programs: TRIO Student Support Services and TRIO Upward Bound.

TRIO Student Support Services (SSS) works with first-generation college students currently attending PFW.

To qualify, students must be studying for their first bachelor's degree at PFW and also be a first-generation college student (neither parent has earned a 4-year degree), meet federal income guidelines, or have a documented disability registered with the Disability Access Center.

SSS services include individual academic advising, tutoring, workshops, peer mentoring,

career exploration, financial literacy, cultural and volunteer events, and more. There is also a TRIO Resource Room in KT G30. TRIO SSS's goal is to provide support and resources to first-generation students to help them get through college and successfully graduate.

TRIO Upward Bound is a college-prep student program that works with income-eligible high school students who are future first-generation college students in specific area high schools. It provides academic support, tutoring, learning experiences, mentorship, and assistance with applications and financial aid forms to help eligible high school students get into college and give them the tools to succeed once they're there.
