The FRIENDS of The University Pantry at Purdue Fort Wayne is a free resource dedicated to reducing food insecurity, both on campus and in the broader community. The Pantry is stocked with perishable and nonperishable food items to meet immediate needs and provide a sense of belonging. The Pantry is open to visitors each day it operates, and students are permitted to visit up to three times per week. Visitors are encouraged to bring their own reusable bags.

A wide range of individuals and groups, including faculty, staff, university departments, and local businesses and individuals, come together to ensure The Pantry is stocked with a variety of frozen, packaged, and canned goods. In addition
