What the Officers Do

Each office has a unique role in the functioning of the CSSAC board and CSSAC as a whole.

- **Chair:** Schedules and runs board meetings, appoints board members to serve on committees, and is the Fort Wayne representative to West Lafayette's CSSAC board
- **Vice Chair:** Runs meetings in chair's absence, serves as acting chair if necessary, and takes minutes in secretary's absence
- **Secretary:** Takes and distributes board meeting minutes, serves on Outreach Committee, and helps oversee communication
- **Treasurer:** Tracks and reports on CSSAC account balances, serves as chair of Finance Committee, and oversees fundraising

Did you know that the Center for Healthy Living is available for staff, too? They're an affordable and convenient option for blood draws, lab work, vaccines, primary care services, and more. If you're on one of Purdue's medical insurance plans, they are a Tier 1 provider and offer preventative care at no charge and non-preventative care for a small flat fee. Plus, they're very familiar with the Healthy Boiler physical form! If you're not on Purdue's insurance, they also bill other health insurance plans.
