Chancellor Carwein has said that Action Plan 41 and the USAP process are about making "strategic decisions to allocate resources **according to the priorities identified in Plan 2020,**" How is it, then, that Action Plan 41 completely ignores key priorities of that Plan 2020, while disproportionately favoring others. For example, there is virtually no acknowledgement, let alone a plan of action, for the goals of internationalization (I.C.2-6) and interdisciplinarity (I.C.1). Since these crucial goals of Plan 2020 have been excised from Action Plan 41, are we to understand that the university has abandoned them as priorities?
