Call to Order

<u>Discussion of Committee Purpose and Structure</u>

Dehr, Kopec, and Stone discussed the purpose of the committee. It was decided not to pursue breaking this committee up into two separate committees, one devoted to Marketing and one to Development and Alumni Relations.

Discussion over to keep the name as is. As per Stone, the term "Advancement" encompasses both development and marketing and should be kept for that reason.

Discussion of Administrative (Ex-Officio) Members

Stone recommends she and Michelle Shaw, Director of Annual Giving & Stewardship, as Development & Alumni Relations ex-officio members.

Discussion of Change to Language in Senate By-Laws

Suggested change to 5.3.5.2.1.10.2.2.:

Advise the Chief Advancement Officer the Vice Chancellor of Marketing and Vice Chancellor of Development & Alumni Relations on matters of advancement;

Report from VC Stone on Development activities

Stone reported to the committee with a PowerPoint presentation. Some of the information reported included:

- Changes to stimulate and sustain alumni engagement from alumni to PFW Foundation.
- Updates on personnel the that reports to her office.
- Return to "Community Focused," rather than inward focused.
- Report that the Covid-19 crisis has allowed the office to incorporate new technology in reaching out to donors.
- Report that office also established a Covid-19 Student Relief Fund, which raised nearly \$80,000 in three weeks.
- Report that Day of Giving (in September) was an increase from 215 gifts to 634 gifts (year-to-date)—from \$277k to nearly \$500k.
 - The event increased in donors and, importantly, in new donors.
