


Brief description of the program:

The Department of Mathematical Sciences has modeled the proposed minor on the Actuarial Science major. The current B.S. in Actuarial Sciences has coursework leading to three exams of the Society of Actuaries and three Validation by Educational Experience (VEE) topics. The minor in Actuarial Science will require students to complete coursework leading to two actuarial exams and required for one Validation by Educational Experience topic.

Brief rationale for program request:

Since the Department of Mathematical Sciences launched its B.S. in Actuarial Science program in Fall 2017, there has been significant interest in a minor in Actuarial Science from the Doermer School of Business and its students. The proposed minor will meet this interest.
