



Re: Law and Public Policy Concentration

Brief description of the program:

Criminal justice students currently have no concentration options. The proposed law and public policy concentration would be one of two options for criminal justice students interested in a career in law enforcement.

Brief rationale for program request:

The major objective of the proposal is to broaden the appeal of the criminal justice major; students will have two concentration choices in the criminal justice major in the BSPA program if the dual proposals are endorsed: law and public policy and criminal justice policy. The proposed new concentration would be another opportunity for interested students to engage in public service as a career upon completion of the baccalaureate degree.
