Because it is un-official, students are inaccurately placed in the orchestral instruments concentration so that they have a code for myBLUEprint and the Course Plan of Study (CPOS) evaluations. Adding this concentration will provide guitar performance students with a transcript that accurately reflects their studies. Of the sixteen students currently in the BM performance with orchestral concentration, currently four are guitarists. Creating a new concentration and obtaining a concentration code for guitar will make students' transcripts, myBLUEprint, and CPOS accurate.
