Qualifying students are eligible to receive financial assistance for the dual credit courses at their high school. 21 st Century Scholars funding is not available until after the student graduates from high school.
	I understand that if the student needs to withdraw from a PFW class, the student must contact the PFW Collegiate Connection office by the dates listed in the <i>Collegiate Connection Student Handbook</i> . If the student does not contact the Collegiate Connection office, I understand that I will be responsible for all fees incurred.
	I understand that any courses registered for or grades earned are a permanent part of the student's university transcript, <u>regardless of the grade earned</u> . Failing college classes has consequences and may impact future federal financial aid.
	I understand that it is the student's responsibility to verify with the college or university the student plans to attend if the course(s) will both transfer to the institution and fit into the academic major.
	I understand that once the student begins classes, all of the student's records including, but not limited to, academic records, financial records, medical records, etc., are protected by the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
