### Use the Demo Student Tool

#### **Overview**

The Demo Student Tool provides you the ability to add a fake student to your course and impersonate the Demo Student so that you can see the course from a 'real' student experience. You may want to use this tool for the following purposes to make sure your course is configured correctly:

- Test your course before it goes live.
- View content, submit assignments, and take quizzes.
- View published feedback and grades.
- Troubleshoot a live course when things don't behave as you expected.

**NOTE:** The demo student is associated with each course independently and cannot be transferred to another course. Use the same steps in each course that you wish to use the tool.



### Part 1: Add a Demo Student to a Course

1. Click **Course Tools** in the navigation bar.




2. Scroll down the list of Course Tools and click on **Demo Student.** 




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
3. Click the **Create Demo Student** button to add a demo student to the course.



4. When successfully added, the page will indicate that a demo student is in the course.



5. At the bottom of your classlist, you will find the demo student enrolled.



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# Part 2: Impersonate a Demo Student

The Impersonate option allows you to view the course just as a student would. You can check the availability of content and activities, post discussions, submit assignments, take quizzes, and view the gradebook. Navigate to your course and follow these instructions:

1. Click Classlist in the navigation bar.

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
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2. Navigate to the Demo Student and click the dropdown to the right of the name and select **Impersonate.** 




3. Click **Yes** in the popup that appears. This suspends your current session and logs you in as the selected user.



**NOTE:** Your course appears as it would to your students. You can perform student functions such as taking quizzes and submitting assignments.

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4. When finished, click the Demo Student's name in the top right and click on the **X** to stop impersonating.



### Part 3: Remove the Demo Student from a Course

1. Click Course Tools in the navigation bar.




2. Scroll down the list of Course Tools and click on **Demo Student.** 



3. Click the Remove demo Student button to remove the demo student from the course.

**Note:** If you select Remove demo student, all the progress made using the demo student will be lost and cannot be retrieved.



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
