## Part 1: About Kaltura captions.

- 1. As of Fall 2024, Kaltura is auto-captioning every video that is uploaded. This is a mandate from Purdue West Lafayette to be consistent with accessibility initiatives.
- 2. If you notice your video does not have captions, reach out to a CELT consultant today for the step-by-step information.

## Part 2: Edit Captions.


1. When in the My Media, select the pencil icon to the far-right of the video to edit the captions.



- 2. Below the video, locate the tabbed menus and select the Caption tab.
- 3. Scroll down as needed and select the Edit Captions button.
- 4. The captions and the video will show side-by-side. You can edit the captions as the video plays by selecting the section of the captions you'd like to update. Then make the desired changes.
