Some courses moved between departments in Education in 2008. Electrical and Computer Engineering Technology changed to Computer and Electrical Engineering Technology and Information Systems and Technology in 2009. Information Systems programs moved from CS to CEIT in 2009. CS 106 changed to ETCS 106 and moved to ENTS in 2009. ESL programs moved from TRS/CASA in Arts and Sciences to Mastodon Advising Center in Unit of Affiliated Programs in 2009. ENG R150 replaced by COAS W111 in 2009. Organizational Leadership and Supervision moved from independent division to Engineering, Technology, and Computer Science in 2009--prior years restated. Sociology and Anthropology divided into separate departments and Visual Arts divided into Fine Arts and Visual Communication Design in 2009--prior years restated.
