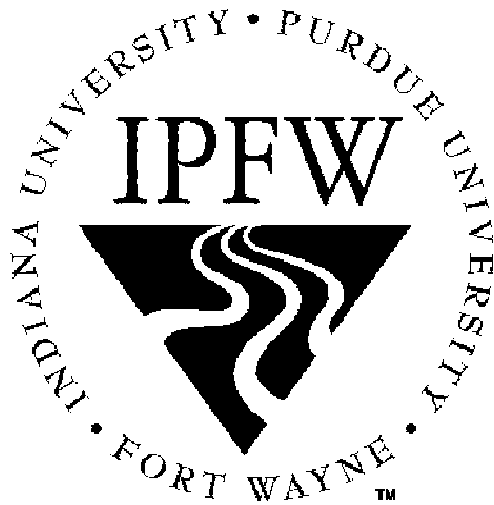

Programs in the School of Education moved between departments in 2005. English R150 courses moved from Center for Academic Support and Achievement to English and Linguistics in 2007. Most pre-business students moved from ACCS to BMS in 2007. Some courses moved between departments in Education in 2007. Military Science credits first offered in 2007 and shown in ETCS. Civil and Architectural Engineering Technology and Mechanical and Industrial Engineering Technology departments combined to form Manufacturing and Construction Engineering Technology and Interior Design in 2008 - prior years restated. Academic Counseling and Career Services changed to Mastodon Advising Center in 2008. Most pre-business students moved from Mastodon Advising Center to Business and Management Sciences in 2008. Organizational Leadership and Supervision moved from independent division to Engineering, Technology and Computer Science in 2008. Information Systems program moved from CS to CEIT in 2008. CS 106 changed to ETCS 106 and moved to ENTS in 2008. ENG R150 replaced by COAS W111 in 2008.
