d a t	If attendance can be justified as an essential part of how the course is taught and/or how learning is to be demonstrated and measured, there can be a point at which disability-related absences cannot be reasonably accommodated. If at any point, the instructor and/or the student have any questions or concerns about this process, he Modified Attendance Agreement and/or the provision of this accommodation, the Disability Access Center should be notified as soon as possible, so they can address the concerns and work to resolve them.

If the maximum number of allowed absences is exceeded during the semester, the student and instructor must communicate an appropriate course of action (such as: student will be granted an incomplete; student will be advised to withdraw from the course; the number of absences allowed will be reviewed, etc.) The Disability Access Center should be informed as soon as possible so they can work with the instructor and student to come to a reasonable solution.
