Student Housing Winter Break Preparation

If you are a resident of student housing at any of our locations, please remember to complete the following checklist <u>before</u> leaving for break. These items are essential for helping keep our buildings safe, secure, and ready for your return.

- All thermostats should be set to HEAT and set at 70 degrees.
- Make sure all perishable food items are removed from the fridge and thrown away so they don't rot while you are away.

- Take out all trash—these last two instructions will also help avoid unpleasant smells.
- Make sure all windows are closed tightly and locked to prevent pipes from bursting due to the cold; anybody remember what happened last year!?
- Close all the blinds in your apartment and make sure you shut off all lights before leaving for break.
- Dishwashers and washer/dryer units should be totally empty.
- If you have an emotional support animal, take it home with you!
