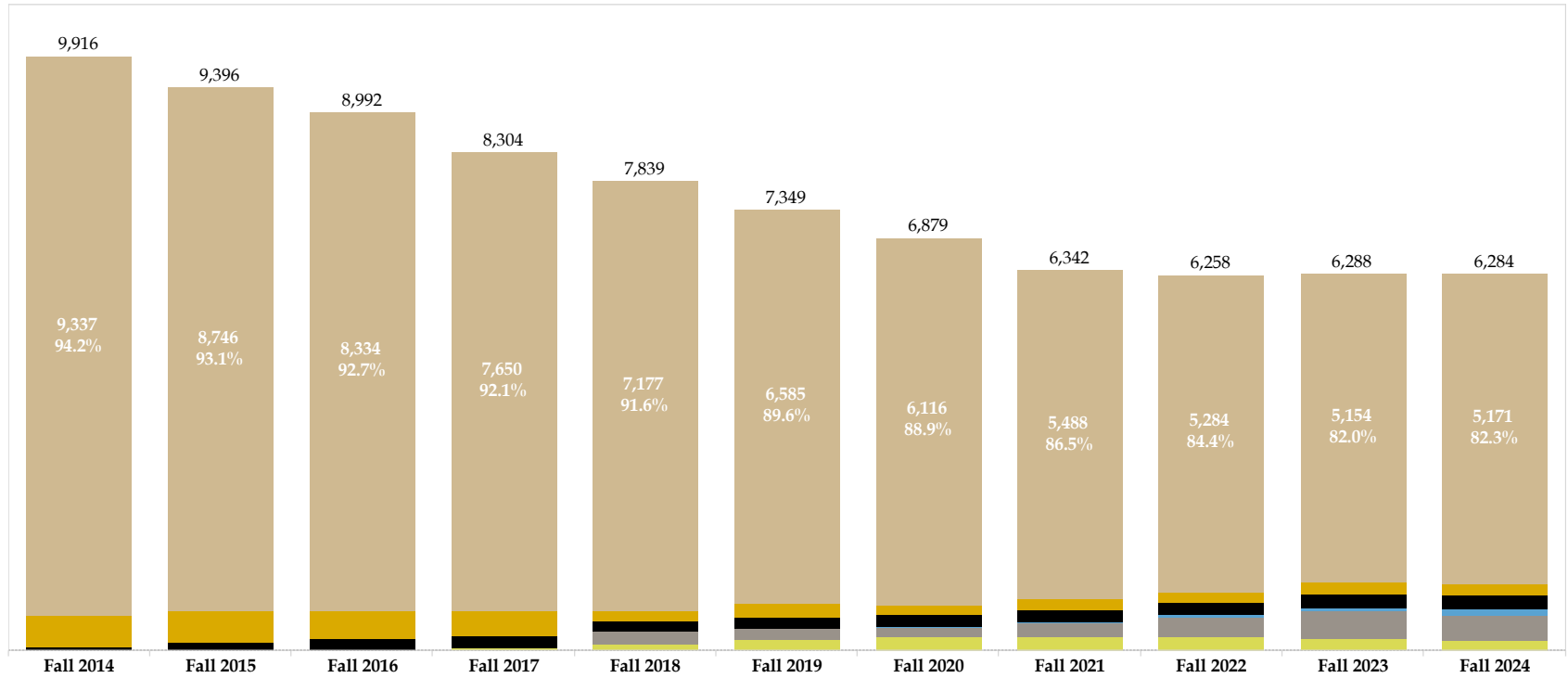

Tuition Reciprocity programs include Midwest Student Exchange Program, Ohio Reciprocity agreement counties, and residents in the four states contiguous to Indiana (Illinois, Michigan, Ohio, and Kentucky)
