Whereas the following units--

Business and Economics, Dental Auxiliary Education, Education, Labor Studies, Library, Music, and Public and Environmental Affairs--

are recognized as independent academic/administrative units within the Indiana University system, within the administrative structure of IPFW, and by their respective accrediting bodies.

For purposes of clarity, recognition of these units as having academic/ administrative independence should be included in the documents which govern the faculty of IPFW. Therefore, we are proposing the following amendments to ensure that it is realized that Professional Studies is a term used to group these units only for the purposes of representation in the Senate. Administratively, the seven units listed, with the exception of Labor Studies, report directly to the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs.
