SUBJECT: Funding for a Fine Arts Building  
DISPOSITION: To the Presiding Officer for action

WHEREAS, Facilities for the fine arts at Indiana University-Purdue University at Fort Wayne are generally deplorable, and

WHEREAS, The state legislature has appropriated insufficient funding for a fine arts building on the Fort Wayne Campus, and

WHEREAS, The state legislature set a precedent by requiring local, private funds to complete an academic building at a public university, which precedent we reject as inappropriate,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, The Fort Wayne Senate recognizes President Beering's efforts to secure state appropriations for the proposed fine arts building on the Fort Wayne Campus, and asks President Beering to continue his efforts by making full and proper appropriations for this building a high-priority request to the legislature at the 1986 session.
