WHEREAS, the School of Fine and Performing Arts approved the following changes to its Governance Document in May of 1994.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT SD 88-24 (The School of Fine and Performing Arts Faculty Senate Election Procedures) be amended to reflect those changes.

The School of Fine and Performing Arts has been allocated three permanent seats on the IPFW Faculty Senate. Each department shall elect one member for a three-year term when the term of its current senator expires in accordance with its own election policies and procedures. The School may be If-the-School-is awarded a fourth seat for the following year, based upon the number of voting faculty in the School in a given year divided by 6, . It -it will be filled by the-Bean-of-the-School: a full-time faculty member elected at-large, the term served to be determined by IPFW Faculty Senate procedures.

SCHOOL OF FINE AND PERFORMING ARTS Election of Senators

The School of Fine and Performing Arts has been allocated three permanent seats on the IPFW Faculty Senate.
