Be It Resolved, That the Academic Regulations be revised to amend Section 11, as indicated by the overstruck deletion and boldface addition below.

## 11.0 Minors

11.1 Establishment

A minor-subject program may be established by any academic unit at IPFW subject to approval by the school/division containing the unit, to approval by the Curriculum Review Subcommittee or the Graduate Subcommittee, to acceptance by the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs, and to publication of requirements for completion of the program in the Bulletin or its supplement. Completion of any minor must require a minimum of 12 credits, including at least 6 resident credits at the 200-level or above.
