Subject: Amendment to the Bylaws-Abolition of the Lecture Series Subcommittee

WHEREAS, The Lecture Series Subcommittee is no longer functioning; and

WHEREAS, The functions of the Lecture Series Subcommittee have been subsumed by the Omnibus Lecture Committee:

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Lecture Series Subcommittee be eliminated by making the following changes in the Bylaws of the Senate.

- 5.3.4 ... The Student Affairs Committee shall establish a Subcommittee on Athletics and a Lecture Series Subcommittee.
 - 5.3.4.2 The Lecture Series Subcommittee shall consist of five Faculty members elected by the Senate, five students selected by the Students' Government, and the Director of Student Activities ex officio. The Presiding Officer of the Senate shall annually request the Students' Government to select the student representatives. Student representatives shall serve staggered two year terms; elected Faculty members shall serve staggered three-year terms. The ex-officio member may not chair the Subcommittee.

 The Subcommittee shall:
 - 5.3.4.2.1 Plan and implement an annual campus Lecture Series
 - 5.3.4.2.2 Provide coordination between campus, departmental, and community lecture series
 - 5.3.4.2.3 Submit an annual request for funding for the Lecture Series from the student activity budget.
