Subject Amendment of the Academic Regulations (SD 85-18): Plus-Minus Grading

Date: January 14, 1999

Disposition: To the Presiding Officer for implementation

WHEREAS, adoption of plus-minus grading by the Fort Wayne Senate would provide for system-wide use of plus-minus grading; and

WHEREAS, Purdue University West Lafayette, has recently adopted plus-minus grading; and

WHEREAS, the main campus of Indiana University already uses the same grading system; and

WHEREAS, the proposed change would allow faculty to use this tool in the calculation of grades, on a voluntary basis;

RESOLVED, Senate Document SD 85-18 (Academic Regulations) be amended as follows:

D,D+,D- - Below-average achievement; lowest passing grade

Except in the computation of GPA, these grades are referred to simply as A, B, C, or D grades.

8.0 GRADE-POINT AVERAGES. A grade-point average (GPA) is a weighted average of credits for which a grade of A, B, C, D, F, or IF has been assigned. It is

computed (rounded to two decimal places) as follows:

where NA represents the number of credits assigned the grade of A, NB the number assigned the grade of B, etc.

Proposed:

8.0 GRADE-POINT AVERAGES. A gradepoint average (GPA) is a weighted average of credits for which a grade of A+, A, A-, B+, B, B-, C+, C, C-, D+, D, D-, F, or IF has been assigned. Grade points will be assigned to each completed course according to the following table:

The GPA is the sum of the Grade Points for all included courses divided by the total number of hours those courses. The GPA is rounded to two decimal places.
