6.0 GRADES

6.1 **Basis of grades.** The instructor is responsible for explaining to students, preferably in writing at the beginning of an academic session, the course requirements and grading system to be used. *Beginning students who are classified as freshmen shall be assigned a midterm grade in each course during their first two semesters.* Each All students shall be assigned a grade in each course in which the student is they are enrolled at the close of the session.

The student is responsible for the completion of all required work in each course, by the time of the last scheduled meeting of the course or other deadline set by the instructor, unless the student has officially withdrawn from the course, or unless the student and the instructor have agreed that a grade of Incomplete will be assigned.

6.2 *Midterm and* semester grades. The following grades may be assigned: [No change in the list of grades]

6.5 Midterm and final grade reports.

- 6.5.1 Midterm grades shall be reported to the student and to her/his academic advisor.
- 6.5.2 Each student's complete record for the session and the student's cumulative GPA shall be reported to the student, to the student's major department, and to the student's school/division.
