Despite measures already taken during years of expressed concern, the latest (Nov. 1992) air-quality survey of the Classroom-Medical Building shows that, in more than two-thirds of the areas measured, key pollution levels are above those defined as acceptable by Purdue University. Significant numbers of IPFW employees required to work in this building report symptoms they attribute to the poor air quality. Does IPFW have a plan and a timetable for solving this problem?
