Jack, as Jim Moore explained in an E-mail to you last week, the Department of Organizational Leadership and Supervision needs to change the title of one of our degrees. Specifically, we have been asked by the business portion of SBMS to drop the word "management" in our title of Operations Management Technology. The purpose of this title change is to aid business in the re-accreditation process.

We have been in the "de-manage" phase for about four years now, and I thought that this change had already been made before I became chair. Since you have brought it to our attention, we have had an OLS faculty meeting in which we voted unanimously to change the name of the degree to Operations Technology. Purdue does not have an Operations Technology degree; I think it is a holdover from the DGTS days and that Joe Chandler brought the degree to the Department with him.

Since Purdue at West Lafayette and statewide will probably drop the "Supervision" from the title of their department, we do not want to add Supervision to the Operations Technology degree title. If I need to do more followup on this matter to make it official, please let me know. I have been told that this memo will take care of the situation, but that seems too easy for Purdue.

We sincerely appreciate your bringing the matter to our attention.
