The Calendar Subcommittee shall consist of three Faculty members of each University affiliation, elected by the Senate to two-year terms; one student of each University affiliation, selected by the Students' Government for one-year terms; a member of the administrative staff, selected by the Administrative Council for a one-year term; a member of the clerical and service staff, selected by the Clerical and Service Staff Advisory Committee for a one-year term; and the Registrar, non-voting. The Subcommittee shall develop policies and procedures for establishing a two-year academic calendar for the Fort Wayne Campus. Specifically it shall:
