Passed: 8 Ayes, no Nays. Steve Westrick voting by mailed ballot.



The following information is provided relative to questions pertaining to the Faculty Senate discussion of resolution (SD-82-1) presented by the Subcommittee on Athletics:

1. Application made at the Fall 1982 Conference meeting would seek membership effective with the 1983-84 academic year as the probationary membership year leading to full membership in 1984-85. Following subsequent GLVC action in 82-83 IPFW would have the rest of 1982-83 and 1983-84 to prepare for full membership including schedule implementation.

- 2. NCAA II and GLVC annual dues combined is \$1400. This total cost is less than total annual memberships previously paid for multiple affiliation in NCAA III, AIAW III, and NAIA. The move to NCAA II and GLVC membership has been central to the quest to focus administrative and intercollegiate athletic programs in a unified and more rational mode of effectiveness.
- 3. The academic eligibility of IPFW student-athletes is governed by the NCAA requirements as stated in Article Five of the Bylaws (academic progress) and by GPA progress policies adopted by the Big Ten Conference regulations as applied to Indiana University-Bloomington and Purdue University-West Lafayette.
- 4. Financial summaries of both the operating budget for student athletics and athletic scholarship funds are attached (Appendix A).
- 5. A copy of recent correspondence from the GLVC Commissioner concerning the prospect of IPFW membership is attached (Appendix B).
- 6. This resolution is the culmination of a long review of the campus athletic program which was initiated by an Ad Hoc Campus Athletic Committee appointed in 1979 by the Chancellor's Office. That committee essentially supported and urged the development of a strong intercollegiate program.
