- SUBJ: Requested extension of mandatory retirement age for Chancellor Wartell
- WHEREAS, IPFW Chancellor Michael Wartell is recognized throughout northeast Indiana as providing outstanding leadership for IPFW; and
- WHEREAS, Chancellor Wartell is responsible for the most significant growth in enrollment and facilities in IPFW's history; and
- WHEREAS, The Higher Learning Commission's ten-year accreditation review recognized IPFW as being an outstanding university that is run in a transparent and open manner that fosters a positive learning environment which is due to the leadership of Chancellor Wartell; and
- WHEREAS, The implementation of the Decadal Funding effort will be well-served by the continued leadership of Chancellor Wartell; and
- WHEREAS, Chancellor Wartell's 18 years of service to IPFW will make him an indispensable asset to the planning of IPFW's 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary in the 2013 2014 academic year; and
- WHEREAS, A precedent exists for providing extensions to the Purdue University mandatory retirement age of 65 for highly valuable top-level executives; and
- WHEREAS, The Fort Wayne Senate expresses a clear preference for the new Purdue University President to be involved in the selection of the new chancellor at IPFW; and
- WHEREAS, The members of the IPFW Foundation recognized Chancellor Wartell for his outstanding leadership at its meeting of September 20, 2011, and requested an extension of the mandatory retirement age;
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Fort Wayne Senate urges the Purdue University Board of Trustees and President to grant a two-year extension to the mandatory upper administration retirement age of 65 for IPFW Chancellor Michael A. Wartell.
