PFW and IUFW Campus Will Be Closed Wednesday

The Purdue University Fort Wayne campus including Indiana University Fort Wayne will be closed Wednesday, Jan. 22, because of the dangerously cold conditions that are expected to continue through the morning hours.

All classes, on-campus events, and activities are also canceled. **Unlike Tuesday, the IU School of Medicine will have normal operations and students will receive in-person instruction.**

All dining services will also be closed Wednesday, but the FRIENDS of the University Pantry location in the clubhouse at Student Housing on the Waterfield Campus will again be open from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Essential university personnel should report as scheduled. Please check with your supervisor for additional guidance. All nonessential employees are expected to work remotely, if possible, and all online meetings should continue, as scheduled.

Unless otherwise announced, the campus will return to normal operations Thursday, Jan. 23.
