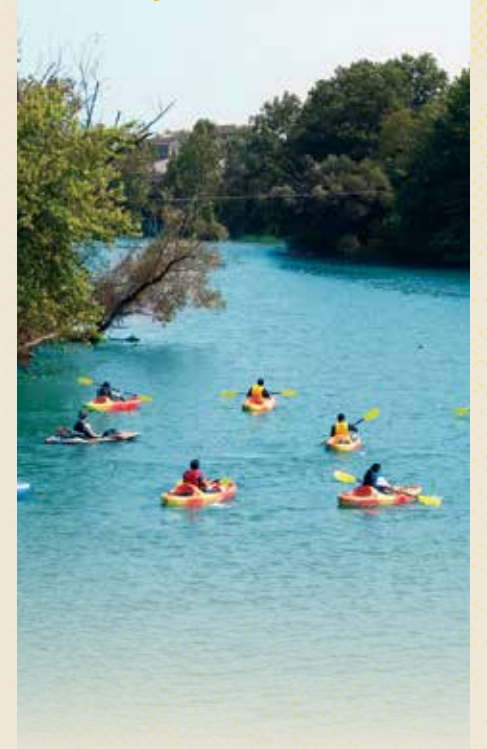
WELL-REC SPIELFREAKS COMMUNITY GAME NIGHTS
