Survey Overview

- The Office of Institutional Research partnered with the Higher Education Data Sharing Consortium (HEDS) to administer the Graduating Student Survey (GSS).
- HEDS is a community of colleges and universities sharing data, knowledge, and expertise to advance undergraduate liberal arts education, educational excellence, and student success.
- HEDS administered the survey to all undergraduate students who have received an award, have applied for graduation or are in pending status.
- The GSS evaluates teaching practices and institutional conditions.
- The question items seek to assess the impact of the student's experience on their intellectual growth and how well it prepared them for success after college, and to describe their plans after graduation.
- The benefit to the University in administering this survey is to get a better sense of what your students hope to achieve, and better monitor and address students' worries and concerns.

Response Rates


- Although the response rate is not particularly high, we believe the results provide valuable insights into students who are set to graduate.
- Note: The survey was distributed to every known email address on file for the student. In the Spring 2023 administration there were instances in which multiple responses were received from individual students. In such cases, if responses were exactly alike, the duplicate entry was removed from the dataset. If the response differed in anyway, the duplicate entry was kept in the data file.



Ethnicity Distribution of Sruvey Respondnets Compared to the Graduating Student Population





Faculty Interaction – Year to Year Comparisons


Most faculty with whom I have had contact at PFW were:





Classroom Experiences – Year to Year Comparisons


About how often have you experienced each?

(% Often or Very often)





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

(% Often or Very often)




NACE Outcomes - Year to Year Comparisons

To what extent has your experience at PFW contributed to your knowledge, skills, and presonal development in the following areas?



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


Outside of the Classroom – Year to Year Comparisons

To what extent has your experience with each of the following at PFW contributed to your learning and personal development?




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






As you think about living a successful life after college, how important are each of the following? (% Very important or Moderately important)




Successful Life and Preparation – Year to Year Comparisons

Successful Life vs PFW Preparation



Overall Satisfaction – Year to Year Comparisons


Overall, how satisfied have you been with your undergraudate institution at PFW?



Thematic Analysis – Successful Life

What experiences at PFW have been most helpful in preparing you to be a successful and live the life you want to lead after college?

Community and Campus Culture:

• Desire for a stronger sense of community and team spirit, moving away from the commuter college feel.

Practical Workshops and Networking:

• Specific workshops, such as those focusing on social networking, are valued.

Academic Support:

• Respondents stressed the importance of academic advisors in guiding success.

Event Accessibility:

• Respondents suggested increasing advertisements and frequency of large student gatherings.

Flexible and Relevant Learning:

• There were frustrations with rigid classroom activities that didn't align with adult students' needs.



Thematic Analysis – PFW Preparation

What could PFW have done to better prepare you to be successful?

Enhanced Academic Resources:

• Respondents emphasized the importance of stronger academic programs, scholarships, and student organizations in preparing for future success.

Improved Advising:

• A significant theme was the need for advisors with real-world experience in students' intended fields, to provide more tailored guidance.

Flexibility in Scheduling:

• Working students expressed a need for after-hours teacher availability and more opportunities for collaboration to fit their schedules.

Skill Development:

 Suggestions focused on building practical skills like multi-tasking and commitment, which are essential for professional success.


Inclusive Collaboration:

 Opportunities to collaborate with students from diverse backgrounds were highlighted as a missed opportunity that could have added value.




PRIMARY ACTIVITY AFTER GRADUATION


Please indicate ONE activity that you consider your PRIMARY plan after you graduate




Which of the following BEST describes the current state of your employment plans?



IF you are planning to attend graduate or professional school at any point in the future, which of the following BEST describes your educational plans?




To what extent does your first job after graduation align with your long-term career interests?
