#### New Requirements for FedEx Shipments

FedEx is no longer supplying mail services at PFW with hard copy forms for shipping. Sending packages via FedEx will now require an account with FedEx so the form can be completed online and printed out by the person handling the shipment.

In order to set up the online account, contact Lisa Eley, director of mail, warehousing, and print services, at **eleyl@pfw.edu**. Accounts should be limited to a small number of personnel in each unit and/or department. Those responsible for shipping in this manner should include their name and account/WBSE number as reference when completing the FedEx form online.
